
I am writing in response to your email dated January 17, 2008 to Drs. Roehrborn and Shariat asking for a correction to UT Southwestern's press release titled "Hormonal Dietary Supplements Might Promote Prostate Cancer Progression."

The observations made for this research study, including the research subjects' purchase and ingestion of the substance in question, occurred during 2001 through 2003. The FDA changed its regulations governing this substance in April 2004. Consequently, at the time that the research was conducted, the product was correctly labeled as an herbal/hormonal dietary supplement and was sold legally, over-the-counter to the subjects.

UT Southwestern Medical Center reaffirms the information included in the press release.
